



Frequently Asked Questions – COVID-19

Will we be seated at one table?

*Due to the social distancing requirements during COVID-19, groups larger than **6 PATRONS** will be seated on more than one table.*

Under the legislation of the Victorian Government, the largest singular group that we can seat at one table is 6, however we will do our best to ensure that you and your guests are seated to best enjoy one another's company.

Are children welcome to dine at Mr Grubb?

We are a family friendly venue and invite your children to enjoy our venue as well as adults. In order to help maintain the health and safety of staff and patrons during COVID-19, we ask that children remain seated for the duration of your stay.

Can I BYO wine or cake?

No, we are unable to serve any food or drink that is brought into the premises from an external source. If you wish to organise a cake to celebrate a special occasion, please get in contact with our staff prior to your reservation and we will be happy to help organise something.

Can our group split the bill?

No, we are unable to split bills at Mr Grubb during this time.

We will also be encouraging minimal contact payment methods and prefer card payments during this time.

Can we order drinks at the bar?

During the current time of COVID-19, you cannot order drinks at the bar. Table service will be offered to all guests.

Can I bring my dog to Oakdene?

We do not allow dogs or any animal on the property at Oakdene. Service dogs are permitted.

Can we book a table outside?

Bookings are made on inside tables only due to weather restrictions.
